

FINDING YOUR FOOTING

THINGS TO THINK ABOUT BEFORE YOU ARRIVE

- Send final transcripts to Admissions (303.458.4900).
- Complete the “Not Anymore” online training. Training contains helpful information about sexual harassment, sexual assault, dating violence, stalking and more. It must be completed by Aug. 27.
- RSVP for New Student Orientation by Aug. 15 at regis.edu/orientation.
- Consider registering for 1st Tracks to experience the Colorado outdoors and meet other students before arriving on campus. 1st Tracks will take place from Aug. 18-22. Space is limited. Visit regis.edu/1stTracks to register.
- Decide about health insurance. You must enroll in or waive the Regis health plan by Sept. 4. For more information, visit gallagherstudent.com/ru.
- Submit proof of immunization history. You must submit documentation by July 15. For more information, visit regis.edu/shs.
- Consider your transportation needs. You can bring a car, but most first-year students do not because of limited parking and the many other ways to get around, including free bus passes, free bike rentals and Regis’ short-term car share program. If you bring a car, you must register it within the first two weeks of the semester at regis.edu/parking.
- If you need or think you may need academic accommodations for your courses, visit regis.edu/disability. Student Disability Services must review your documentation before you can receive accommodations. Review can take up to 14 business days.
- Consider a work-study position. More information will be available during New Student Orientation or at regis.edu/studentemployment.
- Send in a picture to be used on your Regis student ID card to studentaffairs@regis.edu by July 16.
- Consider releasing academic information to your guardians. Once you’re on campus, Regis will primarily communicate with you about most elements of your attendance. To release select information, visit regis.edu/ferpa.
- Sign up for RU Alert, Regis’ emergency communication program, at regis.edu/rualert.
- If you are living on campus, consider setting up renter’s insurance. More information can be found at regis.edu/housing.
